



FOUNDATION'S PROJECTS EMPOWERING RURAL EDUCATION

REACH

This is an extension of the READ program to include differently abled children. The aim is to make these children self sufficient so they can take care of themselves and also enable them to become employable.

With the help of specialist teachers and support staff we partner with various institutions for the differently abled in teaching them sign language, providing special laptops and tablets as well as providing vocational training.

The program is structured in partnership V-Sesh, V-Excel, RASA foundation, Amar Seva Sangam and Amarjyoti



REDINGTON EMPLOYABILITY ACADEMY FOR DEVELOPMENT (READ)



This project aims to equip graduates from the lower socio economic groups with structured holistic training programs so as to improve their chances of becoming employable in a competitive environment.

Training agencies with requisite expertise are engaged to impart employability training skills. We have our own smart learning centers where such training is imparted.

The training is interactive and includes English communication, interpersonal skills, business etiquette, computer training, interview techniques, public speaking, personality development, resume writing, goal setting.

RURAL SCIENCE PROGRAM

Our rural science program, focuses on intensive, job oriented live hands-on training for the students to enable them to be picked up by IT companies.

- Through our Read program we have enabled students in various aspects of Employability Skills Training, however the ROCE - Return On Capital Employed can be measured only when these students are successfully placed.
- Therefore, Foundation is now stepping into carving out a path for the trained students to find the right
 job, at the right location for the right candidate, where by the students can constructively contribute to the
 organization he/she is working for.
- The foundation has initiated in bringing together various corporate highlighting the strengths of the

students in various location through our HR conclave, where by they will be able to select students matching their job requirements.

• The Foundation has also initiated The "Redington Hot Spot" centres under their "Redington Accredited Manning Program" (RAMP) in which Advanced Learning will be conducted for Professional Development and Entrepreneurship for those youth who have compulsion to come out their location and/or those who has potential to be self-employed.
